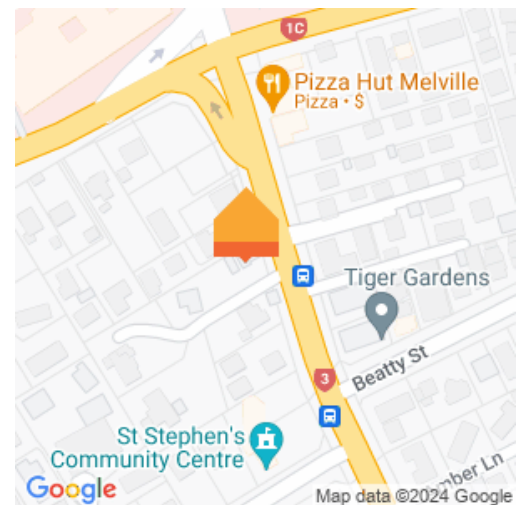


📍 44B Ohaupo Road, Melville

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Steeped in local history, this little cutie, built circa the 1920s, began life as an early dairy on the outskirts of town. The passing of time has seen the site become superbly central and the Rimu building morph into a fine character home full of traditional charm and modern convenience. Delivering kerb appeal, it sits behind a white picket fence in a landscaped environment that beautifully reflects its heritage. Extended some years back and recently renovated from top-to-toe, the dwelling boasts a brand new Coloursteel roof, double auto garaging and a host of internal updates and improvements.
