We were met by Lisa Sigley from Lugtons Real Estate, who was at the showhome located at the entrance off Keston Crescent. We were shown around this stunning community of 30 designer townhouses - Stage 1 started in early 2018 and sold out fast. Since then every stage has sold as soon as they've been completed, or sooner. The excitement builds as they near completion. Lisa tells us there are now only 13 left to sell.

What we loved is that they aren't "cookie

cutter", there's a little something different with each stage. Designed by Award Winning Chow Hill Architects, it just makes them stand out - the look, the design, the layout, the size, the fittings and the landscaping. This is perfect for those wanting a lock-up-and-leave, whilst retaining active and independent whilst living in something very special.

We asked about body corp fees (at an affordable \$58/week) we were surprised to learn that the fee covered insurance, lawn, maintenance of outside, roading, common gardens and an annual house wash.

When asked "What makes people choose Keston Mews?", Lisa said that they love the look and feel of them, you can bring your dog out, the fact that you own the house and land outright and when you go to sell, you get the capital gain. Only 1%

of the sale price goes back into the body corp fund.

We found the spirit of Keston Mews as being friendly. The residents love to catch up for a "cuppa on the corner" and enjoy being surrounded with similar aged and like-minded people. A great concept for those who want to cash up their equity and live a simple, carefree and affordable new lifestyle, and in a designer fashion.

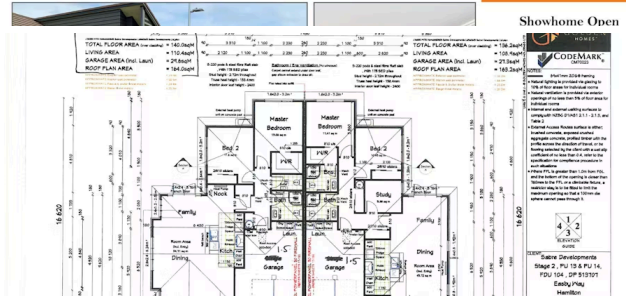
