The village, which is overlooked by sacred Taupiri Mountain, is an easy drive to Te Rapa, The Base and Hamilton central. The property is 7km from Ngaruawahia heading south and 8km from Huntly heading north, which makes things nice and easy to get you on the road to Auckland. The bigger home is a weatherboard construction with a roomy lounge flowing to an open plan dining and kitchen area, both of which are angled for the panoramic outlook over the river and ranges. Both bedrooms are double sized, served by a family bathroom and separate toilet. The laundry is also separate. There is a single car garage and good parking. This character home has been repainted and has a restful ambience, enhanced by a wrap-around deck. The second home is a zincalume dwelling featuring sunny open plan living and two bedrooms. Indoor-outdoor living areas frame uninterrupted views of the river and majestic ranges. Located at the northern end of the Waikato basin, Taupiri has a good range of amenities for a town of its size, including sport and recreation complex, a school, cafe, two halls, a pub and a handful of shops.
