If only the double brick walls could talk because this fine period home has more than 100 years of stories to tell. Built circa 1910 -1919 by Hamilton's then Mayor Fow, the exemplary rimu dwelling has traditionally attracted long-term owners. Interiors set under ornate high stud ceilings are brimful of character yet tastefully modernised for 21st century living. Top-line appliances, including an induction cooktop and pyrotech oven, feature in the kitchen. A conservatory-like porch area and a reception room contribute to the home's diverse living and entertaining options. Built-in cabinetry adds a beautiful retro touch to the dining area. The master bedroom has an ensuite and a third bathroom serves the outdoor studio, which also has good storage. A gas fireplace, gas heater, two heat pumps and insulated ceiling provide a high level of comfort. The fenced 729sqm section houses a double garage, a workshop area and off-street parking. The private rear environment is a pleasurable playground with an in-ground pool and sunny alfrescoes. Extensive cobblestoning means no lawns to mow. Bird life is drawn to the grounds which are green and verdant, and have established veggie boxes.
